## FNSB's Transfer Site Attendant Services for Summer 2018

**Fairbanks, AK:** Fairbanks North Star Borough announces the Transfer Site Attendant Services for 2018. Here are the details:

- Tuesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 and will end Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
- Attendants will be present from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, seven days per week at seven transfer sites.
- The transfer sites with attendant services are at the following locations:
  1. Badger Road, 855 Badger Road
  2. Chena Pump Road, 2395 Old Chena Ridge Road
  3. Ester, 2535 Little Shot Road
  4. Farmers Loop East, 300 Old Steese Highway
  5. Farmers Loop West, 2180 Farmers Loop Road
  6. Fox, 284 Goldstream Road
  7. North Pole, 2740 Old Richardson Highway

Similar to last year's plan, an attendant will be on site each day to greet and assist residents, answer questions and address or improve the following:

- Provide general guidance and traffic directions including maintaining safety barriers around the packer trucks that are emptying the dumpsters
- Redirect the delivery of commercial waste, and junk vehicles
- Discourage use of the transfer sites by City of Fairbanks residents and redirect them to the Solid Waste Facility
- Collection of household hazardous waste
- Safety between users and contractor vehicles
- Monitor & report unsafe activity, including vandalism and drug activity
- Lower costs by reducing unnecessary expenditures

As a reminder, commercial trash and junk vehicles should be taken to the FNSB Solid Waste Facility located at 455 Sanduri Street, Fairbanks. Residential trash tipping fees are waived per FNSB Code No. 21.20.090 A for "loads of non-hazardous waste brought to the landfill from a residence in a passenger vehicle, a pick-up truck, or a trailer with two wheels and a single axle will be considered minor loads if the vehicle is not registered in the name of a company or business or used for commercial purposes."
