Visitors that have entry rights such as MCB, officers, and any other government official will be admitted immediately. Identity and age will be verified upon entry. There will only be one door to enter the restricted access area from the intake room which will remain locked at all times. The area will be marked clearly Restricted Access Area, visitors must be over 21 and escorted in accordance with 3 AAC 306.710.

Describe your processes for admitting visitors into and escorting them through restricted access areas:

Boreal will not provide tours of restricted access areas at this time. Authorized visitors per phone call will enter the front door (remained locked all times) to the intake area and an employee will verify age using a valid government issued ID per 3 AAC 306.350. Visitors will then sign in and fill out all required information on sign in sheet kept with records following reg 3 AAC 306.675. Visitors will then be issued a temporary badge similar to employee IDs which must be worn for the duration of the visit. The badge will designate which employee they are assigned to and said visitor must not leave designated employee's eyesight. Employees will not exceed the maximum 5 visitors : 1 employee at any time. The restricted access door will remain locked at all times for security measures and only employees and management will be authorized have keys.

Exterior lighting will exceed minimum requirements of 20 feet at each entrance in order to provide sufficient lighting for surveillance equipment as required per regulation 3 AAC 306.715.

An alarm system is required for all license types. Describe the security alarm system for the proposed premises:

The alarm system will have magnetic door sensors at the two emergency exits and the main entrance. The facility has no windows. It will have motion detectors that will be installed as a back up to the door sensors. It will be monitored by a third party monitoring agency 24 hours a day seven days a week. Alerts will be sent out via text message automatically and management and local law enforcement will be notified via phone in the event of a break in. Video surveillance will be used 24/7 in which management will be able to view a live feed and assist law enforcement of any situation that arises. Alarm system is to be armed at all times either open mode or closed mode. Open mode will disarm motion sensors but still monitor the door sensors, to allow work inside. Closed mode will arm the entire system. This will act as a backup measure to protect employees during work hours.

The alarm system must be activated on all exterior doors and windows when the licensed premises is closed for business. Describe how the security alarm system meets this requirement:

The alarm system will be armed at the end of each working day. It will have magnetic door sensors on all exterior doors along with motion detectors inside. It will set off the alarm in the event the sensors are tripped and authorities/ management called as previously stated. There are no windows in the facility. The system will be used in conjunction with 24 hour video surveillance.

Boreal will have a zero tolerance policy for marijuana diversion. Cameras will be placed in view of all operations per regulation 3 AAC 306.720. Recording footage will be kept for 40 days. Employees or subcontractors caught diverting product will be terminated immediately and reported to the authorities and marijuana control board. Only upper management will have keys to the curing, quarantine, and finished product rooms. Inventory will be checked regularly via Metrc in order to audit product on hand in conjunction with video audits done at the discretion of management. Employees will be required to keep personal belongings in lockers prior to entering the restricted access area.

Describe your policies and procedures for preventing loitering:

No loitering signs will be posted. Anyone loitering will be asked politely to leave the property and refusal will result in a call to the police for assistance with the situation. Loitering will be discouraged by having visitors call our phone number to schedule visits and a locked door at all times. Loitering will be observed from monitors inside and employees will act accordingly. 3 AAC 306.715.

Describe your policies and procedures regarding the use of any additional security device, such as a motion detector, pressure switch, and duress, panic, or hold-up alarm to enhance security of the proposed premises:

Motion detectors will be installed with the security system. We will also install a panic alarm and siren pending security system compatibility.

Any potential waste will be stored in lockable containers such as lockable trash cans or storage containers until approval for destruction in Metrc.

We will mix ground marijuana waste with our used coco growing medium and compost it in drums for reuse or disposal by an authorized waste company. We may mix it with other material approved by the MCB under AAC 306.740 (D)(1)(2).
