

TANANA LAKES RECREATION AREA

GENERAL PARK RULES

1. Facility Hours - Summer Hours: 6 a.m. until 11 p.m. / Winter Hours: 6a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.
2. No overnight camping.
3. Please swim only in designated swimming areas because of extremely cold water conditions. Rules for swimming beach are posted. Do not swim immediately after meals and do not become over-exerted while swimming. There are no lifeguards. Swimming is AT YOUR OWN RISK.
4. No dogs are allowed in the swimming beach area. In other areas, dogs must be kept on a leash.
5. No glass bottles are allowed in the swimming area.
6. Special permits are coordinated through the Parks and Recreation Office at 459-1070 for special activities, group gatherings, spectator attractions, etc.
7. Visitors must leave the facility clean and orderly.
8. Cushman Lake is closed to all aircraft and motorized boats.
9. Music can only be played at a volume that does not infringe on other people's enjoyment of the Park.
10. Parking is allowed in designated spots only.
11. No boats are to be within the buoys marking the swimming beach area.
12. Everyone on board a watercraft within the recreation area must wear a personal flotation device at all times.
13. No person shall knowingly emit a false drowning alarm.
14. Fires are to be in designated sites only. Do not leave a fire unattended. Portable barbecue grills are allowed.
15. No fireworks are allowed in the Park.
16. The loading or discharge of firearms, bows or crossbows, are prohibited for public safety reasons anywhere within the recreation area during the summer season. Firearms may be used during autumn hunting season for waterfowl. An Alaska Hunting and Sport Fishing License is required to hunt and fish in the Park.
17. The setting of a steel trap or snare is prohibited for public safety reasons anywhere within 100 feet of a designated trail or roadway.
18. Do not pick, cut, deface, remove or otherwise damage any flora, fauna, structure, or property in this Park. However, gathering berries or mushrooms for personal consumption, but not for sale or distribution, is allowed. Fines may be issued for property damage. If you find a lost or injured animal of any kind, do not pick it up, but inform a Park employee.
19. Motor-driven scooters and cycles must conform to state licensing laws and their use will be confined to developed roadways. ATV usage in the Park is allowed only in designated areas.
20. All local, state and federal laws apply within the Park.
21. Police emergency services are provided by the Alaska State Troopers @ 451-5100. In an emergency, dial '911'. For general park information, call the FNSB Parks and Recreation office @ 459-1070.
